

MENIFEE VALLEY AMATEUR RADIO CLUB; VHF NET PROTOCOL v3d

Note; highlighted italic info is advice for the Net Controller.

At 6:25pm please announce on the repeater, (W6CDW-R, 144.895 + offset, pl 156.7) that the Menifee Valley Amateur Radio Club weekly Net will begin in 5 minutes. (At 6:30pm). Club Call sign is N6MVA. This is a good time for Net Control to get a radio check to verify a solid signal into the repeater. Then, at 6:30pm, open the Net.

IS THE FREQUENCY IN USE? <N6MVA> (BREAK)

QRZ: A CLEAR FREQUENCY IS REQUESTED.

If at any time there is any emergency or priority traffic the Net will standby. <N6MVA> (BREAK ; four seconds)

QST: MENIFEE VALLEY AMATEUR RADIO CLUB meets on this frequency every Tuesday at 6:30 pm Pacific local time for our weekly Net. We encourage LICENSED GUEST check-ins and their contributions. (BREAK)

Our monthly CLUB MEETING convenes on the second Thursday of each month in the Community Room of the Provident Bank in Sun City. We gather at 7:00 pm for social exchanges and the meeting begins promptly at 7:30 pm. All visitors, licensed or not, are welcome. Contact us at our Website www.menifeevalleyarc.org or FACEBOOK. (BREAK)

This is a DIRECTED NET, meaning all traffic must go through your Net Control station. This week your Net Control operator is < NAME, CALL SIGN, and LOCATION >.

Is the ARRL Audio News available? (BREAK)

I will now hand over the net to our Club President, John Pashley (J.P.) AG6PZ, for our weekly announcements.

<N6MVA> *President, or stand in, makes the announcements.*

Are there any other announcements before roll call? (BREAK)

First, I will call CLUB MEMBERS from the latest Net Check in list, followed by missed or late CLUB MEMBERS.

Next I will call for GUEST check-ins, followed by their comments.

Then I will poll the CLUB MEMBERS for their comments.

**When checking in, please SLOWLY and CLEARLY give your NAME , FULL CALL SIGN, and LOCATION only.
ITU PHONETICS APPRECIATED. <N6MVA> (BREAK)**

Now proceed with the Club roll call, etc.

***Allow 8 seconds for Echolink contacts; (see Net Check in sheet).
Use 'Echolink/W6CDW-R' to view contacts.***

Take breaks to call for late or missed check-ins.

***Mention the Club Website several times during the Net.
